The CTCleanEnergyOptions program allows residents to support energy produced from clean, renewable sources such as wind, water, and sunlight. By selecting a clean energy option from one of the two companies listed below, you are authorizing them to purchase Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) on your behalf. You will continue to receive service on one electric bill from Connecticut Light & Power, but with a small additional clean energy line item charge. Average electricity users will pay an additional \$4 to \$9 per month, depending on their exact kWh per month usage. Additional cost per kWh is listed below. There is no termination fee to end your participation, simply notify the company you choose directly. CTCleanEnergyOptions was developed under the direction of the CT Department of Public Utility Control.
